

**Committee recommendations for funding of proposals

The Initiative received 18 proposals requesting a total of \$212,214. At our November 4, 2016 meeting, the committee decided on the following recommendations:

The committee decided not to fund summer salary requests across the board.

Should additional money become available, the committee ranks Donehower and Sauer as the proposals to receive additional funding.

Funding Decisions as Amended by Dean Storrs

Fund as recommended except:

- 1) Ask English to absorb the cost of instructors to release Alberts from 2 courses (later approved by the Chair of the English Department), for a savings of \$11,383.
- 2) Use the savings to add travel back into Donehower's proposal, for a total of \$4,269. Donehower was ranked first to receive additional funds if available.
- 3) Use the savings to add travel back into Sauer's proposal, for a total of \$16,881. Sauer was ranked second to receive additional funds if available.
