UND is partnering with Global Citizens Network (GCN) for the Brazil Field School to offer students the opportunity to gain in-depth knowledge and understanding of the Xukuru (Shookooroo) people in northeastern Brazil. Students will live and work alongside the Xukuru throughout the three week experience, while assisting in community development/construction projects that support and respectfully preserve Xukuru indigenous culture and identity. The Brazil Field School works to increase student understanding of, and respect for, Xukuru culture and community life while cultivating and promoting the values of peace, justice, respect, and cross-cultural understanding within a global perspective.
