LEARNING

AIM: Promote an accessible and comprehensive educational experience through opportunities that develop and showcase a broad understanding of the world, its diverse people, and how we live in it.

OBJECTIVE: Meet the academic needs of a diverse student body that is increasingly seeking flexible ways to learn and earn a degree or other academic credential.

The College of Arts & Sciences will:

- Support the utilization of best practices and ongoing pedagogical development in face-to-face and online instruction, including universal design for learning and other accessible and inclusive pedagogical strategies.
- Invest in continued development and growth of flexible educational opportunities, including online courses and programs, SPEA, and new opportunities.
- Strengthen the relationship between professional academic advisors and faculty.

OBJECTIVE: Support and promote opportunities for students to apply and showcase their learning.

The College of Arts & Sciences will:

- Enhance the Undergraduate Showcase to support participation by students from all four divisions within the college, including online students.
- Strengthen cross-campus partnerships to enhance student career awareness and development opportunities.

AIM: Foster the professional development of faculty and staff, building skills and enhancing leadership potential among the personnel who are integral to fulfilling the College mission.

OBJECTIVE: Invest in skills and leadership development of A&S faculty and staff.

- Sponsor developmental opportunities for faculty, including activities from various entities outside of UND.
- Sponsor developmental opportunities for staff, including activities from various entities outside of UND.

EQUITY

AIM: Ensure equitable access to opportunities and resources within the College.

OBJECTIVE: Promote fair and sustainable work practices beginning with the point of hire.

The College of Arts & Sciences will:

- Review workload distributions among faculty and staff, including remote work arrangements.
- Create a salary equity plan for the College.

OBJECTIVE: Support student success by reducing barriers to educational attainment.

The College of Arts & Sciences will:

- Promote faculty use of low- or no-cost classroom resources.
- Provide additional financial support for students through development of new endowments and enhancement of existing scholarships and funds.
- Work to smooth the transition to and through college among first-generation and underrepresented students.

AIM: Facilitate opportunities that increase awareness of, understanding, and appreciation for diversity, equity, and inclusion.

OBJECTIVE: Engage campus and community partners through DEIA+ related efforts and events.

- Collaborate with campus offices to facilitate DEIA+ related opportunities for students, staff, and faculty.
- Strengthen the presence and role of the College's Inclusion Ambassadors.

AFFINITY

AIM: Promote a sense of community and belonging through a common identity that reflects our shared values and goals.

OBJECTIVE: Increase awareness of the College and its four divisions while highlighting the unique contributions of each field to A&S.

The College of Arts & Sciences will:

- Broadly market A&S programs and events to increase participation and appreciation among diverse stakeholders that support the liberal arts and mission of the College.
- Involve students, faculty, and staff at events that showcase the unique skills and talents of those within the College.
- Support or host events that bring together members and friends of the College, to learn, socialize, and form new partnerships and collaborations.

AIM: Celebrate the goals and accomplishments of the A&S community.

OBJECTIVE: Improve communication, collaboration, socialization, and recognition of accomplishments and opportunities.

- Recognize and reward faculty and staff with outstanding achievements.
- Publish and circulate a periodic communication highlighting faculty and staff achievements.

DISCOVERY

AIM: Create an open environment in which collaborative exploration and discovery are encouraged.

OBJECTIVE: Promote new and existing research and creativity activity efforts, including those that are collaborative and interdisciplinary and that involve students.

- Engage in hiring and career advancement processes that align with and enhance areas of strength within the College, or have the potential to contribute to multi- and/or interdisciplinary RCA teams.
- Foster new partnerships by hosting events meant to bring together College faculty involved in research and creative activity.
- Provide additional infrastructure and support for faculty and students engaged in research and creative activity, including pursuit of extramural funding or opportunities.

SERVICE

AIM: Support scholarly events and opportunities that facilitate service across A&S.

OBJECTIVE: Support balance and equity for faculty and staff participation in service activities.

The College of Arts & Sciences will:

- Review current service efforts among faculty and staff to better understand capacity and enhance equity.
- Foster and recognize community involvement and service partnerships.

AIM: Engage local and statewide communities through targeted outreach and development of key partnerships.

OBJECTIVE: Promote public education in the arts and sciences.

- Enhance the presence of the humanities and arts across the state of North Dakota and the nation.
- Strengthen the relationship between UND and K12 educators in the local community.
- Expand curricular work and facilitate transfer pathways with local tribal college partners.
