

Academic Intervention Policy Approved on September 15, 2023

- 1. Student performance in coursework will be reviewed by faculty at the beginning of each semester.
- 2. If a student's cumulative GPA falls below a 3.00 then:
 - a. The student will be placed on academic probation for one semester.
 - b. The student will be dismissed from the CSD graduate program if at the end of their probationary period the cumulative GPA is still less than 3.00.
- 3. If a student has earned a grade lower than a 70% in a course, then the following consequences will ensue:
 - a. The student will repeat the course.
 - b. The student will be allowed to repeat the course only once.
 - c. The instructor and the student will develop an intervention plan.
 - d. The student's advisor and department chair must sign to acknowledge the intervention plan.
 - e. A copy of the plan will be placed in the student file.
- 4. If a student has earned a grade lower than a 70% in a formative assessment tied to an ASHA Knowledge or Skills standard in a course, then the follow consequences will ensue:
 - a. An intervention plan will be developed by the instructor and the student to address the knowledge/skill expected to be acquired.
 - b. The student's advisor and department chair must sign to acknowledge the intervention plan.
 - c. A copy of the plan will be placed in the student file.
