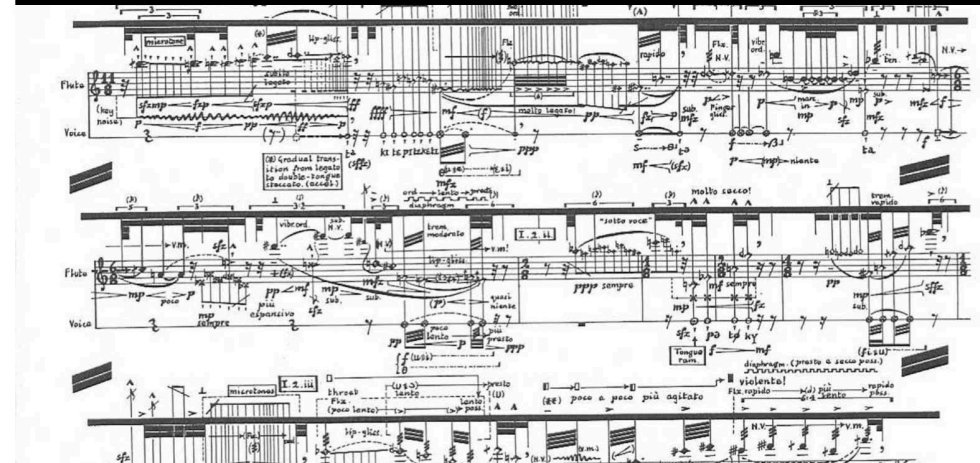


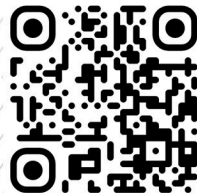

PROGRAM NOTES

Just An Average Day is the musical translation of inspiration for what would otherwise be a screenplay idea, following the plot arc and beats of a typical adventure story. We meet the protagonist in the A section and the main melodic motif, unaware of what's to come and just living life. In the B section, our protagonist faces her first minor villain, just a taste of the struggles to come, and succeeds, resulting in her finding her driving motivation to start her new adventure. The A section returns and the protagonist continues on her journey confidently. In the C section, the protagonist meets her new allies and for a while, it's all fun and games. But then we reach the D section, where the real enemy shows himself and the protagonist is forced to fight back or lose everything she's gained so far. The B section returns as the protagonist inches toward victory but grows desperate while success moves out of sight. The protagonist finally puts together the pieces for victory as her main melody takes the stage and she and her allies overcome the villain.

Big Yellow Flowers: This song is not about flowers.
