Suggested Timeline for PCAT Preparation

Fall semester

- ⇒ Learn as much as you can about the test
- ⇒ Make a study plan for spring semester
- ⇒ Get review materials

Weeks 1-8 of Spring Semester

- ⇒ Review and take practice tests

Spring Break

- ⇒ Fill out WICHE forms (AK, AZ, CO, HI, ID, MT, NV, ND, UT, WA, WY residents)

Weeks 9-16 of Spring Semester

- ⇒ Review and take practice tests

April

- ⇒ Register for July test date

June

- ⇒ Take final practice test

July

- ⇒ Take PCAT for the first time
- ⇒ Work on PharmCAS (opens mid-July, try to submit by mid-August)

August

- ⇒ Retake PCAT if necessary (scores returned within 5 weeks)
