



Itterman Faculty Professional Development Award, 2019

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

The Itterman Faculty Professional Development Award was established in order to support a teaching award for a faculty member demonstrating excellence in teaching, research, and service within the College of Arts & Sciences. The maximum award will be \$1,500 and can be paid as salary (minus taxes) or the full amount could be placed in a local fund to enhance faculty development for the awardee.

Department Chairs and Program Directors are invited to nominate a faculty member for the Itterman Faculty Professional Development Award. (Any full-time faculty—including those on special appointment—in any College of Arts & Sciences department or program are eligible.) Letters of nomination should be no longer than 2 pages and include a description of how the faculty member is an exemplary educator while also maintaining excellence in her/his research and service activities. If necessary, you may be asked for additional information at a later date. Chairs/Directors are welcome to include faculty in the nomination process if they choose. Please limit your submission to one nomination per department/program.

The deadline for receipt of nominations is **March 8, 2019**. Please submit your letter of nomination to the College of Arts & Sciences Dean's Office in MS Word or PDF format via email at: carla.spokely@UND.edu. In the email subject line, please type, "Itterman Faculty Professional Development Award."

The College of Arts & Sciences' Executive Council will be asked to rank the nominations and make a recommendation to the Dean who will make a final decision.

The award recipient will be announced at the Spring semester all-college meeting.
